
Pediatric Medical Traumatic Stress:

A CEU program for Nurses





Every day, children are injured or involved in accidents requiring attention to both their medial and emotional trauma.

This learning module provides an introduction to the types of traumatic stress reactions that nurses typically see in the early aftermath of medical injury and trauma. You will also learn to identify the signs and symptoms of emotional trauma in children and to address it in the context of everyday nursing care.



Using case examples, this module will help you:

- See trauma through the eyes of two children, Emily and Tariq.
- Understand Emily and Tariq's differing emotional reactions and identify their signs and symptoms of emotional trauma.
- Address their distress using simple questions and interventions from the DEF protocol [Distress, Emotional Support and Family].
- Addresses common concerns you may have about assessing or addressing emotional trauma in the context of usual care.
